

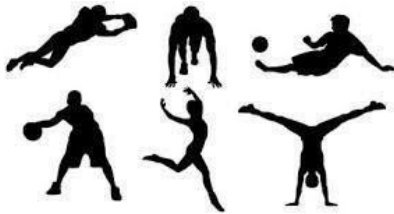

## Level 5 Professional Vocation Qualification: Primary School Physical Education Specialism & Subject Leadership (2024-25)



### **Timeline: Level 5:**

## **The Qualifications and Outcomes**

Bespoke physical education and school sport qualifications for **Primary School Teachers; Coaches; Higher Level Teaching Assistants and Teaching Assistants** developed by the Association for Physical Education and Leadership Skills Foundation (LSF). The aim of the qualifications is to upskill primary colleagues to be able to TEACH and lead the delivery of high-quality primary school PE; School Sport and Physical Activity. The course will especially impact upon the top 3 concerns of subject knowledge, health and safety and subject leadership thus impacting upon the DfE Vision Statement:

***'All pupils leaving primary school physically literate and with the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport'***

The qualification's learning outcomes will subsequently impact upon sustained high quality planning and delivery of the recently issued prescribed national five indicators that are:

1. the engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
2. the profile of PE; Sport & Physical Activity (PESSPA) being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
3. increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
4. broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils

## Why Participate and What are the Benefits?

- The course will provide a structured programme for schools to reflect and develop their own PE, school sport, health and well-being opportunities; therefore enhancing pupil experiences and learning outcomes
- The qualifications will be an effective use of the primary physical education and school sport premium funding in addressing the goal of continuous professional development
- The course will utilise regional expertise to enable relevant and bespoke delivery including (if required) additional support and mentoring opportunities.
- With the Primary PE & Sports Premium extended for this year, this is really expected to be the final year when it is possible to undertake this course with all costs (including any supply cover) fundable via this **ringfenced grant** for schools. Course content really will guarantee HQ sustainable impact upon the **quality of teaching and learning (See sample of testimonials on p1)**
- **Course qualification complies with 'working towards' QTS status that is expected to be mandated**

## Entry Requirements

This course is open to members of staff employed by schools (not externally contracted sports coaches who are not on the school's payroll). The course is therefore targeted at:

- School Sports Coaches or PE Specialists
- Qualified Teachers
- Primary PE Subject Leaders
- Teaching Assistants and HLTAs

## Course Content

The guided six tutor days (and one optional seventh day) are spread throughout the academic year and they include a range of modules with delegate tasks to be completed outside of these sessions. Course modules include:

- Understanding primary school physical education
- Principles of pedagogy in primary school physical education
- Planning for continuity and progression in primary school physical education including impact within the wider school community
- Using assessment to impact on learning and progress in primary school physical education
- Good and outstanding features of teaching and learning within Primary PE with positive implications for the broader curriculum
- Physical Literacy and developing pupils' analytical and evaluative skills
- Grant funding and sponsorship opportunities

## Duration of Course

This Level 5 Certificate will consist of approximately x 141 hours, which includes x 45 tutored hours across x 6 days and x 96 independent learning hours to be completed in your own time, inclusive of your teaching time. Please note that there are delegate tasks to complete that include small written assignments and that schools can utilise PESS Premium funding to enable any required additional release time including supply cover costs, to access personal study time. **The completed portfolio of evidence can then be employed as a whole school staff PE CPD resource base including self-audit tool, that in turn demonstrates outstanding practice regarding sustainable impact related to enhancement of teaching and learning practice and Subject Leader management.**

## Cost

The Level 5 course will cost £1,200 per delegate with limited places available. **It also includes an optional on-site 1: 1 day visit by myself at your workplace as further personalised assistance to course outcomes at no extra cost. Complimentary access to next academic year's Termly Primary Physical Education and PSHE Subject Leader Forums as well as full access to website resources will also be included:** <https://www.londonseprimarypehwb.co.uk>

## Delivery Of Course

The delivery of the course for this academic year will be conducted on-site however there is the flexibility to conduct some units of work virtually as back up in the case of delegate absence on certain dates due to illness/ personal unforeseen circumstances. **Tutor delivery will be typically delivered onsite face-to-face delivery at SLUK accredited course centre, Southborough Primary School, Petts Wood, Kent BR2 8AA. (rail and bus transport links easily available with the school situated nearby)**

BACK-UP Tutor Days will be administered via **Microsoft Teams** (where appropriate) supported by distribution of resource materials as well as additional 1:1 remote contact whenever needed. **Microsoft Teams** is a **free application** enabling you to join a dedicated group as a guest. 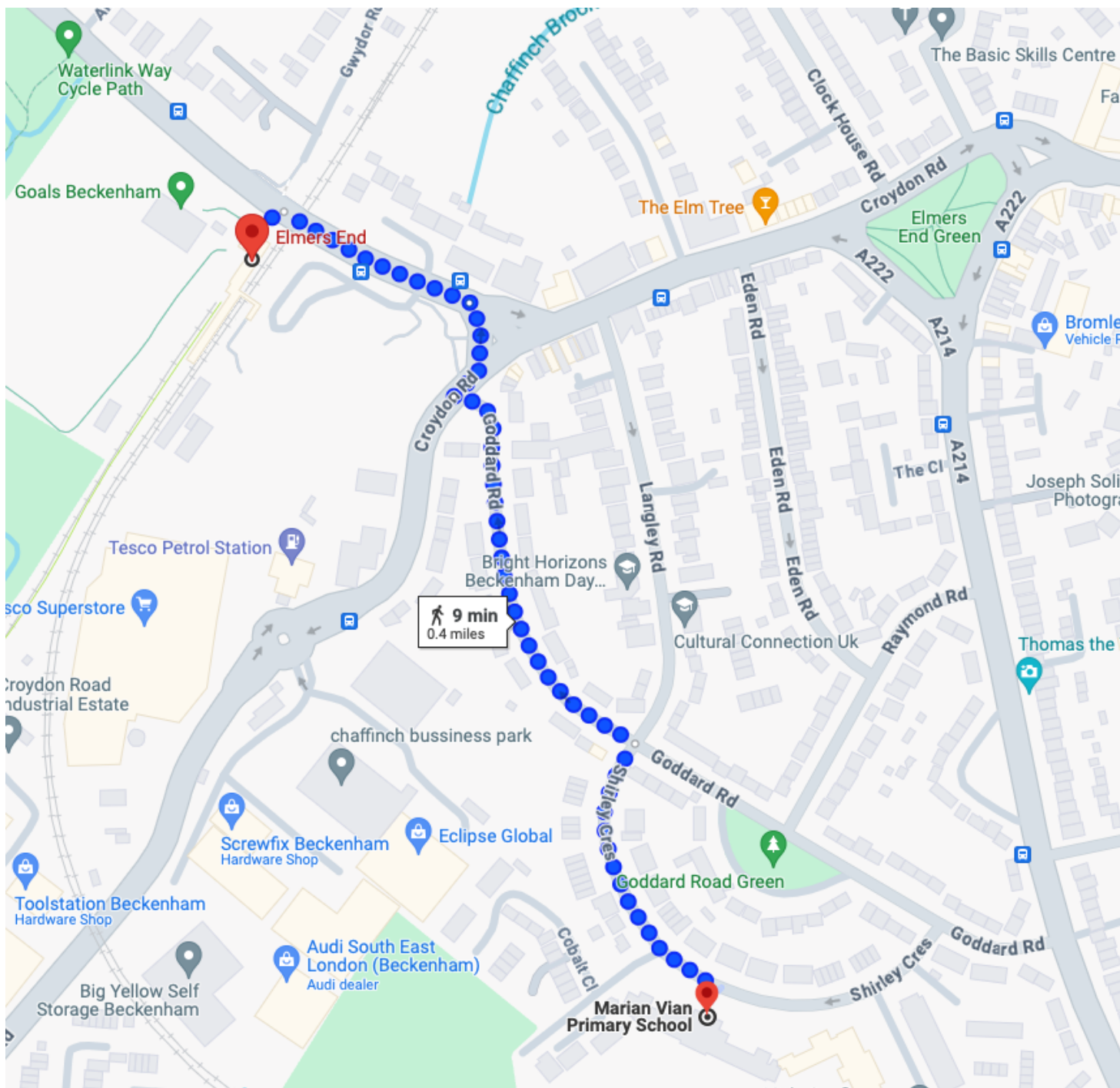
